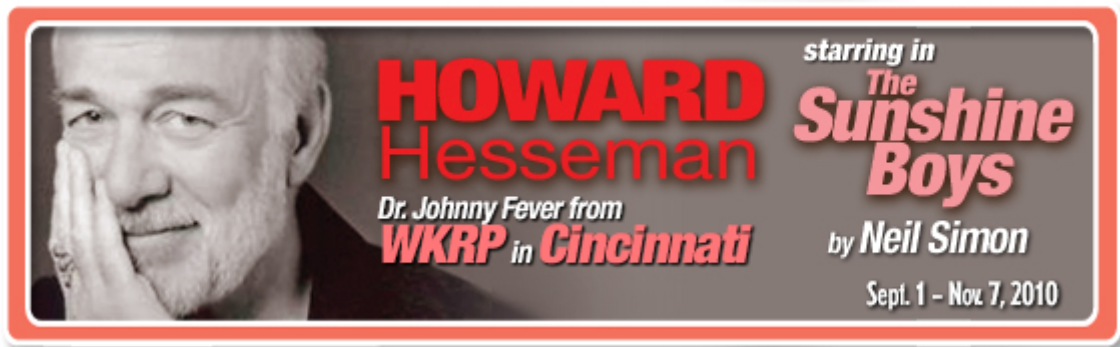


Theatre Day Trip to Kansas City
